A

Example A shows a 3-measure sequence. Measure 1 is G, measure 2 is C, and measure 3 is D7. The strumming pattern is a consistent sequence of down and up strokes: Down, Up, Down, Up, Down, Up.

B

Example B shows a 3-measure sequence starting at measure 4. Measure 4 is G, measure 5 is C, and measure 6 is D7. The strumming pattern is Down, Down, Up, Down, Up, Down, Up.

C

Example C shows a 3-measure sequence starting at measure 7. Measure 7 is G, measure 8 is C, and measure 9 is D7. The strumming pattern is Down, Down, Down, Up, Down, Up.

D

Example D shows a 3-measure sequence starting at measure 10. Measure 10 is G, measure 11 is C, and measure 12 is D7. The strumming pattern is Down, Up, Down, Up, Up, Down, Up.
