Ending Words, Enunciation, Elision

Consonants:

B
C

Grouped by how they are created:

Sibilants: (ssss sound) C, S Z

Labials (use lips) B, F, V, M, P

Glottals (use tongue on teeth or roof of mouth): D, J, K, L, N, Q, T

Gutterals: G, R, (X)

The other kind: H, W

Ending Words clearly

Enunciating (clearly speaking the consonants inside the words)

Elision: when the ends of certain words “slide” into the beginning of other words
